

# Eucharistic Congress Freeman FAQs

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**Q: What are freight services? Do I need to purchase them?**

**A:** Freight services only apply to exhibitors who normally ship materials to the GICC prior to the Eucharistic Congress. The GICC has updated their policy for receiving and holding materials. They now charge a fee for holding your materials at the security office.

Freeman, the company we already utilize for the booth structures, also provides freight services at a competitive rate to the GICC. With Freeman, exhibitors will ship their materials directly to Freeman's facility and they will be held there until the Eucharistic Congress event. On June 1<sup>st</sup>, Freeman will bring the materials to the GICC and deliver them to your booth or table space. Freeman will also be available at the end of the Eucharistic Congress to pick up your materials for return shipment. (Vendor is responsible for having prepaid shipping labels on each box.)

**Q: When can I ship my stuff to Freeman? Where do I ship it?**

**A:** Your freight shipments can begin arriving to the Freeman facility as of May 2<sup>nd</sup> and will be held there until the event on June 1<sup>st</sup>. All shipments must arrive at the Freeman facility no later than May 25<sup>th</sup>. If they arrive after May 25<sup>th</sup>, you will incur an additional fee.

**Q: Why do I have to pay for a service that used to be free? How much is this going to cost me?**

**A:** Unfortunately, we have no control over freight services and have to abide by the rules put into place by the GICC. We researched several options and chose to go with Freeman as our freight vendor because they had the best price, they will deliver direct to your booth/table space, they will bill exhibitors directly (as opposed to going through the Archdiocese as a middle man), and we have worked successfully with them for years at this event already.

The cost for freight services is dependent on the weight of your shipment. For a small shipment of 30lbs or less, the cost is \$40 per shipment. For any other shipment from 30lbs up to 200lbs, the cost is \$157.00. Any shipments over 200lbs are an additional cost of \$78.50 per 100lbs. *For example, a shipment weighing 250lbs would cost you  $\$157.00 + \$78.50 = \$235.50$ .*
